Current Situation:

Camden County has been affected by the powerful winter storm that moved through the area in the last 48 hours. The Camden County EOC has been monitoring this situation for the duration of the event providing updated information to the State EOC and NWS as necessary. On Monday evening Governor Nixon declared a State of Emergency for Southern Missouri.

Laclede Electric Co-Op – no mass outages reported other than individual incidents

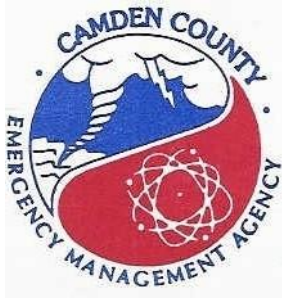
CO-MO Electric – no mass outages reported other than individual incidents

SHELTERS:

American Red Cross is coordinating shelter agency for Camden County. Those shelters are coordinated through the Camden County Emergency Management Agency.

ROADS:

Camden County Road and Bridge Crews are working on clearing roads to a passable state (not complete clearing, just passable) and assisting Special Road Districts as requested. Camden County Road and Bridge Crews are working 12 hours on and 12 hours off to comply with DOT requirements and will stop during the overnight hours, other than to support emergency services needs.

EMERGENCY SERVICES:

The emergency services organizations within Camden County are reporting only minimal call volume related to this storm. Lake Ozark Fire has added additional personnel to handle their potential call volume during this event.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT:

The Camden County EOC is in monitor status and is available to coordinate requests and assets. There will be no further briefing regarding this event unless conditions change. The Camden County EOC will return to normal operations at 4:30PM today January 28, 2009.
