MONDAY 10/01/2018

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Greg Hasty, District #1 Commissioner Beverly Thomas, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve today's agenda as posted. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes) Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:05 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve September 21, 2018 and September 27, 2018 minutes. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

New Business

Road Petitions – Commissioner Hasty stated that we have five for today.

Kays Point # 2 Lot 933 - Commissioner Hasty asked if anyone was present for this petition. No one is present for opposition or for the petition. Commissioner Thomas stated this is for the Horseshoe Bend Road District. Commissioner Thomas then made a motion to approve the road vacation. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Kays Point # 2 Lot 934 - Commissioner Hasty asked if anyone was present for this petition. No one is present for opposition or for the petition. Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve the road vacation for Lot 934. Commissioner

Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Coffman Bend #12 17 Twin Oaks Point - Commissioner Hasty asked if anyone was present for this petition. The owners of the property are present and come forward. They stated they are trying to sell to the property and this is the last item they have to take care of. Commissioner Hasty stated that a road vacation is not what is best for this property. They just need a license agreement and that will leave them with a non- clouded title. Commissioner Williams made a motion to deny the road vacation with the agreement to have a license agreement done and to be completed by the county attorney. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion is denied by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Old Spencer Creek Right of Way - Commissioner Hasty asked if anyone was present for this petition. The owner of the property is present and states that he recently had a legal description completed since the petition was file. Please note that the recent legal description is currently attached to the said petition. Commissioner Williams then made a motion to approve the road vacation. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Blevens Acres – Commissioner Hasty stated this petition was carried over from January that was tabled. Commissioner Hasty asked anyone was present for this petition. No one is present for opposition or for the petition. Commissioner Thomas stated since there are no agreements from the subdivision and it is dedicated to all the lot owners they cannot vacate said road. Commissioner Williams made a motion to deny this road vacation. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion is denied by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Williams (Yes). Copy of all the petitions can be furnished upon request.

Sheriff Agreement- Commissioner Thomas asked the sheriff if this is the same agreement they do every year for the LANEG group and is there any changes.

Sheriff Helms stated that the only change is that they cannot seize assets. Camden County has been elected by the board of directors to take all the money they seize. Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve the LANEG Fiduciary Agreement at the sheriffs' recommendation. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda: Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Hasty (Yes). Session closed at 10:37 A.M.
