

COUNTY COMMISSION RECORD, CAMDEN COUNTY, MISSOURI
THURSDAY 8/30/2018

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Greg Hasty, District #2 Commissioner Don Williams, and District #1 Commissioner Beverly Thomas.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve today's agenda as posted. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes) Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve August 29, 2018 minutes. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

New Business

Bid Opening – Instant Notification System- No bids have been received for this RFQ. No motion made as nothing was received.

Recorder- Ordinance – Commissioner Thomas stated that this is for duplicate names on subdivisions. County recorder Donnie Snelling stated that there is a general ordinance, but he does not have the authority to reject the name on a plat. He stated this becomes a problem for the assessor's office and the mapping department within the assessor's office when they have the same name or a description of the property (i.e. Northwest corner of lot....) that is the same within the county. Not only is it confusing for the assessor's office it also becomes an issue for the title companies and the contractors. He asked if Charlie could put an ordinance together that he could reject a conflicting or confusing name and maybe have within that ordinance that the recorder's or assessor's office have to approve the name before it can be recorded. County attorney Charlie McElyea

stated that he could put something together and bring it to the commission to adopt. No motion at this time, as the county attorney will put together an ordinance and then county commission can vote to adopt.

Road and Bridge Asphalt- Road and bridge administrator Lee Schuman stated that he has a list of asphalt approach priorities with in order from the highest priority to least. He stated he would like the commission to approve the roads in the order as stated. Lee listed the roads as follows; first is East Branch Road, High Point Road, North Oak Meadow, J.R. Hunt Road, Woodall Road and then Rockdale Drive. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the county engineer's list of recommendations for asphalt approachments. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Adopt Gen Gov. Meeting- Commissioner Hasty stated that they have talked about this and Green County currently has adopted this meeting. Commissioner Hasty stated we have a lot going on right now that effects all the offices and the elected officials. This is a great way to get everyone together. All the meetings will have to be posted, and anybody is welcome to attend these meetings. They are to start and end before everyone has to go to work for the day. Commissioner Hasty stated they are going to see how Green County currently works and then put they can adopt the procedure here.

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda: Commissioner Thomas made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Thomas (Yes). Session closed at 11:03 A.M.
