The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to amend today's agenda moving item 1 to 5th. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the December 29, 2022 minutes. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes).

New Business

New Meeting Procedures – Commissioner Skelton explained he is working on implementing new meeting procedures. He will also divide the meetings into two categories regular sessions and working sessions. Today's meeting was classified as a working session.

Youtube/Live Streaming – Commissioner Skelton is making plans so all Commission meetings will be live streamed. He discussed possibly a Youtube channel. This would enable citizens to view all meetings at their convenience.

Updates on Current Issues – The Commission briefly discussed current issues concerning the Commission. These include the water leak in the new wastewater office, Veregy updates, the need for P&Z board members and a P&Z Administrator. Other issues discussed were ULUC and lot sizes, decommissioning of Tunnel Dam, and Good Neighbor Rd in Kinderhook.

Discuss Clerk and Minutes – After much consideration the Commission has decided to keep the task of minute taking within the Commission office for now. This seems to be in line with what most first class counties are doing.

Commission Thoughts/Priorities – The Commission listed some of the priorities they are currently looking into. These include the County Master Plan, Citizen Committees, rewriting the ULUC, and the use of Macks Creek and Climax Springs parks. The Commission would like to have an elected officials meeting the 3rd Wednesday of every month.
