

# COUNTY COMMISSION RECORD, CAMDEN COUNTY, MISSOURI

Thursday 01/05/2023

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton and District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan. District #2 Commissioner Don Williams was out of office.

## Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve today's agenda. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Skelton (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

## Prior Minutes

The minutes from 01/04/2023 had not been completed. No action was taken.

## New Business

**ULUC – 15' Roadside Set Back** – The Commission discussed returning the roadside setback rule of the ULUC to 15' from 25'. This would allow property owners to utilize more of their property. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the new setback. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Skelton (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

**Butterfield** – The Commission discussed the ban on citizen Josh Butterfield in 2020. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to permanently lift any ban against Josh Butterfield entering County property. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Skelton (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

**Cart Maps/Crater Hill** – The Commission discussed the need to update the cart maps for the County. This will help clearly define what is and is not a County road.

This will hopefully help to avoid controversy such as what happened on Crater Hill Rd.

**Schraeder Law Contract** – The County has in the past signed an annual contract with the Schraeder Law firm to help with the interpretation, definition, and implementation of the State statutes. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the contract for 2023. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Skelton (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

**BKD Contract** – The company, BKD, has in the past helped the County understand and follow the federal rules as how to legally use the ARPA funds obtained by the County. The contract with BKD is up for renewal. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to table the approval for renewal pending further review. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Skelton (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

**Adjourn:** With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Skelton (Yes). Session closed at 10:55 A.M.

Ordered that the Commission adjourn until Monday January 9, 2023.
