The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, First District Commissioner James Gohagan, and Second District Commissioner Don Williams was present at 9:35 A.M.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve today's agenda.

Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote:

Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Skelton (aye). Session opened at 9:30 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the minutes from December 28, 2023. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Skelton (aye).

New Business

Road Petitions-

- a. Horseshoe Bend Special Road District petitioned to vacate a portion of Greensboro Court. County Counselor, Jeff Green, spoke with members of HSBSRD and verified the information presented in the petition prior to today's meeting and gave his blessing to approve the vacation.

Commissioner Skelton opened the floor to any parties who wished to speak in favor or against the petition to vacate. There were no parties present to represent this item on the agenda. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the Horseshoe Bend Special Road District's road vacation.

Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Skelton (aye).

- b. Dolly Baker Subdivision- tabled at the last Road Petitions meeting- the County Counselor requested that the petitioner get permission from the landowner at the end of the lane, but the petitioner has since just purchased that land. There were no parties present to speak on behalf of this road petition. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the road vacation. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Skelton (aye).
- c. Lamplighter Drive- tabled at the last Road Petitions meeting- the County Counselor requested that the petitioner get permission from one of the property owners. The property owner sent his consent via email to the County Counselor. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the road vacation. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).
