Monday 01/09/2023

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to amend today's agenda adding 12/29/2022 revised minutes to the agenda. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the January 4, 2023 minutes. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes). Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve the January 5, 2023 minutes. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Skelton (Yes).

New Business

Road Petitions – Commissioner Skelton announced that there are four road petitions to be reviewed today. The first road petition is for Don Brisbee and Kristena Richey a part of Helm Park Lane. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to vacate this portion located at 71 Helm Park Lane. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes). The second road petition is for Michael and Luanne Ruck on Lakeshore Drive. Commissioner Gohagan, at the recommendation of the HSBSRD Superintendent, made a motion to approve the

portion of Lakeshore Drive petition. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes). The third Petition is for Starla Paul at 665 Coelleda School Road. Commissioner Williams made a motion to table the petition as the amended legal description was not presented. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes). The fourth petition is for Steve Armbruster at 697 Coelleda School Road. Commissioner Williams made a motion to table the petition as the legal description and petition were not presented. . Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

October Abatements – Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to ratify the tax abatements for October tentatively approved previously by a commissioner. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

December Abatements – Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to ratify the tax abatements for December tentatively approved previously by a commissioner. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

Sheriff – 4 Seasons Agreement – The Commission was presented with an agreement between the Sheriff’s Office and the Village of Four Seasons for law enforcement services. This is an annual agreement and Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the agreement. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

Sheriff – 4 Seasons POA Agreement – The Commission was presented with an agreement between the Sheriff’s Office and the Four Seasons Lakesites Property Owners Association for law enforcement services. This is an annual agreement also and Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the agreement.

Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

BOA Appointment – John Beckett – John Beckett was nominated to fill the open position on the Board of Adjustments. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve John Beckett for the board. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Abstained), and Commissioner Skelton (Yes).

IT Services – The Commission decided to move the management of IT services back under the umbrella of the Commission. Commissioner Gohagan made the motion to move the responsibilities of the IT department to the Commission Office. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

Closed Session – RSMo 610.021 #1 – At 10:38 AM Commissioner Williams made a motion to go into closed session. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by roll call vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Aye), Commissioner Williams (Aye), and Commissioner Skelton (Aye). At 11:45 AM, Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to go out of closed session. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by roll call vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Aye), Commissioner Williams (Aye), and Commissioner Skelton (Aye).

Other Business

12/29/2022 Minutes – Commissioner Williams made a motion to revise the 12/29/2022 minutes to reflect the change of omitting the word line and replacing it with fund in the section “Commissioner Gohagan also made a motion to create a line in the County’s general ledger in which to deposit the funds.” Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).
