

COUNTY COMMISSION RECORD, CAMDEN COUNTY, MISSOURI

Wednesday 01/17/2024

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, First District Commissioner James Gohagan, and Second District Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve today's agenda. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Williams (aye). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the previous meeting minutes (01-11-2024). Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Working Session Business

Road and Bridge- GEOTABS- GPS for all equipment/vehicles- The Commission asked for Sheriff employees' input regarding their satisfaction with Verizon's GPS system and if they thought that would be a good fit for Road and Bridge. It was stated that Verizon could put tracking equipment in Road and Bridge vehicles/equipment for a little over \$2,000 per month. Chad Bailey stated that using Verizon for their GPS monitoring is just like using a cell phone- when there is no service, there is no tracking. Bailey recommended MOSWIN radios for the graders and supervisors to start out. Commissioner Williams volunteered to take over finding a solution for this issue. There were no motions made on this agenda item.

Parking Ordinance Change Request- Horseshoe Bend Special Road District- The County Counselor, Jeff Green, received an email early December 2023 with a request to change the parking ordinance due to vehicles parking along the shoulders/right-of-way on Horseshoe Bend. Mr. Green stated that with the current ordinance in place, law enforcement on the Bend had authority to place 48 hour tickets on said vehicles then have them towed at the owner's expense. It is his belief that this issue could be solved by enforcing the current ordinance in the area and that the current ordinance does not need to be changed. There were no motions made on this agenda item.

Discuss ownership/policy of Purchasing Property/Items with County Funds- Commissioner Skelton stated that each office holder, department head, elected official should be conscious of their spending in regard to needs versus wants. There were no motions made on this agenda item.

Issues/Communications/Updates- Commissioner Gohagan gave an update regarding fuel usage for the past few years. This information was provided from the Assistant Administrator at Road and Bridge. Boone County has sent over information regarding their fuel policy that the Camden County Commission is going to look further into to see if it's feasible for our county to utilize. North Shed Supervisor, Kendall Conklin, provided the Commission with a simple fuel log that his employees will be utilizing as well until further policies are put in place. There were no motions made on this agenda item.

Elected Officials- There was no discussion on this agenda item.

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day.
