The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, First District Commissioner James Gohagan, and Second District Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Williams made a motion to amend today's agenda to include discussion of the Prosecuting Attorney's budget under other business. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). Session opened at 10:03 A.M.

Prior Minutes

There were no minutes present to be voted on. Commissioner Williams made a motion to table the minutes. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

New Business

Sheriff's Office & Justice Center Security Updates- Decision- Elliott Data Services- Information regarding where the money will come from to pay for these services and hardware has not been provided at this time. Commissioner Skelton has a concern with the warranty portion of the proposal and the cost of those services. Commissioner Williams made a motion to table this item on the agenda until February 1, 2024. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Other Business

Discussion- Prosecuting Attorney's Budget- Richelle Grovesnor was present to address an issue she is having within her budget. She claims that her office is considered short staffed compared to other county's with the same caseload. Her first question to the Commission was in regard to the victim advocates grant fund that the state refunds the county for. She states that the numbers do not match in regard to how much the state refunds versus how much her county budget reflects is refunded from the state. She has been unable to obtain an answer from the Auditor's Office. There was discussion of where the funds will come from within the PA's budget for a secretarial position and LEST funds going out and coming in were discussed as well. A budget amendment for a new employee was agreed upon by the Commission and Prosecuting Attorney. The PA is not requesting more money, she's just moving funds around within her current budget. There were no motions made.

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes). Session closed at 11:01 A.M.
