The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton and District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan. District #2 Commissioner Don Williams was on vacation.

## Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve today's agenda. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Skelton (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

## Prior Minutes

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to table the January 24, 2023 minutes. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Skelton (Yes).

## New Business

**Juvenile Justice Center- Bid Opening** – The Commission met with Brandy Shrauger from the JCC to go over the bids to replace the Hybrid Fire Panel. At this time, additional information is needed before a decision can be made.

**Surplus Property- HH** – The Commission discussed sending out a RFQ to have this lot of land owned by the county appraised. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to accept; Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Skelton (Yes).

**County Owned Property at the Junction of N. Business Rte 5 & Old Rte 5** – The Commission discussed sending out a RFQ for an appraisal and survey of this lot owned by the county. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to accept; Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Skelton (Yes).

**Rhonda Hooker- ARPA** – The Commission met with Rhonda Hooker, representing Lake Are Counseling and Behavioral Health (L.A.C.A.B.), regarding ARPA funds being allocated to the community through this program. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to encumber \$50,000.00 to L.A.C.A.B. Commissioner Skelton seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Skelton (Yes).
