The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Greg Hasty and District #1 Commissioner Bev Thomas. District #2 Commissioner Don Williams was absent.

## Meeting Agenda

## New Business

**Courthouse Administration Closure Policy** – Commissioner Thomas made a motion to release a preliminary statement regarding this policy that will be followed by a formal policy to be written by the county's legal counsel. This interim policy will be effective beginning today February 3, 2020. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes) and Commissioner Hasty (Yes).

Camden County Commission Policy Regarding:  
Closure of the County Administration Grounds for Inclement Weather  
Adopted February 3, 2020 Pending Legal Review

The Camden County Commission by Missouri Statutes is in charge of the buildings and grounds of all county properties. Nothing in this policy will limit or diminish the Camden County Commission's authority to make exceptions to this policy for exceptionally dangerous conditions.

Under ordinary conditions of inclement weather the County Administration building will remain open according to regularly posted hours.

If there is significant snow or ice that is difficult for our grounds crew to keep clear, the commission may direct that only the handicap side entrance be opened. If that is the case, a sign will be placed at the front entrance to that effect.

During inclement weather conditions, no employee may be compensated for hours not worked.

Each elected official may, at their sole discretion, allow their employees to use comp time or other available time paid time, if they are not able to safely get to work.

Each elected official, at their sole discretion, may allow their employees to work additional hours outside of regular courthouse hours as comp time when they were unable to get to work safely.

**Adjourn:** With no further official business on the agenda: Commissioner Thomas made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Hasty (Yes). Session closed at 11:14 A.M.
