The Commission strongly urges each elected official to encourage their staff to partake in the cyber security training program to stay alert to tactics performed by hackers.

Commissioner Gohagan informed those present for the meeting that Phase 1 of the forensic audit is complete and Phase 2 is moving along. Austin Fax is the new Sunshine Attorney for Camden County. No votes were taken on this agenda item.

Elected Officials- The Commission and elected officials are planning to do a walk-through tour of the courthouse to see the progress made on Wednesday, February 15, 2023 at 10:00 A.M. The Commission would also like to meet with the elected officials the last Wednesday of the month. No votes were taken on this agenda item.
