The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

#### **Meeting Agenda**

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to amend today's agenda by removing item 3 as the citizen was not present. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

# **New Business**

Macks Creek Community Park- Jim Sherrell- The Commission met with Jim Sherrell to discuss maintaining the park and forming an active Park Board. A one-year lease agreement was presented clearly stating that the Park Board would be responsible for basic upkeep and maintenance of the park, and the county would maintain liability. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the lease agreement and Commissioner Gohagan seconded that motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

Water Dist. 4 & 5- ARPA Funds and Grants- The Commission met with representatives from both water districts on the agenda today to talk about concerns and needs for repairs. ARPA Fund distribution was discussed based on what was previously allocated to each water district based on the repair costs presented to the Commission.
