Contract Addendums for Assessor's GFI Contract to Include SB190 Operations-

There were two contracts for the Assessor's Office. The first one was for The Hunter Group to implement software processing to the current contract to include operations for SB190. The total cost is \$4,000.00 to add this software. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the contract changes with The Hunter Group. Commissioner Gohagan seconded. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). The change to GFI's contract would include two new printers for the Assessor's Office that would be paid in monthly installments of \$241.86. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve this contract with GFI. Commissioner Gohagan seconded. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

February 2024 Tax Abatements- Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the February 2024 Tax Abatements that were previously tentatively approved by an employee of the Camden County Commission. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Discuss Possibility of Leasing Vehicle for Commission with Enterprise-

Commissioner Skelton discussed briefly the possibility of leasing a new vehicle for the Commission. There were no votes on this agenda item.

Macks Creek Community Park Discussion- Jim Sherrell, Macks Creek Park Board Director, was present to address the commission regarding a road-block with the park obtaining its 501(c)(3). Due to this issue, they're unable to purchase the new playground equipment at the original cost. Jim requested the county accept a donation in the amount of \$60,277.27 for improvements to the Macks Creek Community Park. The commission would use those funds to purchase the new playground equipment. The County Counselor called Commissioner Gohagan and gave advice that there should be no problem accepting the donation to purchase the equipment. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the acceptance of the donation from the Macks Creek Park Board for the improvements to the park in the form of playground equipment. Commissioner Gohagan seconded. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Three Brothers Meat Co.- DNR Discussion- Owners Ira Moss and Todd Lane (Chris Lane is the third owner and was not present) were present to discuss an ongoing issue they're having with DNR regulations/permitting. They gave a brief summary of the history of the slaughter house (previously Tom's Slaughter House on A road in Linn Creek) and requested support from Camden County citizens and elected officials in fighting against DNR and the EPA. Ira Moss notified the commission of a meeting with DNR next Thursday, March 14, 2024 at 10:00 A.M. and requested they be there. There were no votes taken on this matter.

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes). Session closed at 11:02 A.M.
