The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams was absent.

Meeting Agenda

Prior Minutes

New Business

Courthouse Remediation- The commission met with some employees of Veregy, the company hired for the courthouse remediation project. There were no actions taken on this matter other than they said they'd discuss details with the commission regarding clean-up at a later time.

Appointment of LOCLG Board Members- K.C. Cloak is the current Executive Director of the Camdenton Chamber of Commerce. Heather Brown is the Executive Director Lake of the Ozark Convention and Visitor Bureau. Board member, Ike Skelton, was asked to write a letter in support of reappointing if he so chooses- Ike Skelton did state support of reappointing. There was no further comment from others.

OATS Transportation- OATS is seeking support for Capitol Expenditures. Capitol Expenditures are provided 80% by Federal Government and 20% by local funds, private and government. Information was given by Ed Thomas, Director of the Camden County SB-40 Board, about transportation needs in Camden County and how OATS helps fulfill that need.

Issues/Communications brought to the Commission-

- Moving forward with preparation to sell previously identified excess properties.
- Representative Lisa Thomas is seeking input on proposed Casinos in the area.
