The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to amend today's agenda. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:30 A.M.

Prior Minutes

New Business

Payton Ruddy- Representative of Congressman Mark Alford- Intro.- The commission heard from Payton Ruddy, Representative of Congressman Mark Alford. Her goal is to establish a working relationship with Camden County. Her office is out of Columbia, Missouri. Ms. Ruddy let the commission know she is available to discuss any issues, events, and/or concerns.

County Community Clean-up- Camden County Community Clean-up is scheduled to occur on April 30 in the Woods parking lot in Sunrise Beach, Missouri from 8:00 A.M. until 4:00 P.M. Sponsors have asked the county if they can provide the equipment and an operator for lifting the recycled tires into large containers. Commissioner Williams made a motion to table this item on the agenda. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

Phone System- The 911 phone system in the jail currently only gets 150 megabits per second from Spectrum. For the new phone system, they need to be receiving at least 500 megabits per second. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

Veregy Contract- There was a very short discussion on the contract with Veregy, but no actions were taken on the matter.
