The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, First District Commissioner James Gohagan, and Second District Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Skelton made a motion to amend today's agenda to move item two to the last item on the agenda. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Skelton (aye) and Commissioner Williams (aye). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve Thursday, April 18, 2024 meeting minutes. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

New Business

Robert Plumley- Southern Cherokee Drive- Robert Plumley is a resident on Southern Cherokee Drive in Camdenton and is unable to be in attendance for the public hearings that will occur next month in regard to reducing the speed limit on this county road. He stated his opposition for lowering the speed limit and why. The commission was able to ask questions; Plumley answered any questions he was able to. There were no motions made on the matter.

Request for Surplus Funds- Both the Camden County Counselor and Treasurer reviewed this matter and gave approval to proceed. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the request for surplus funds in the amount of \$7,589.88. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Camden County Soil & Water Conservation District- Each year, an annual contribution of \$6,000.00 is added into the budget for this board. The purpose of these districts throughout the state is to focus attention on land and water resource problems. The annual contribution allows this district to continue working with other agencies in providing services to local landowners. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the annual contribution of \$6,000.00 for 2024. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Road and Bridge Bid Openings- There were several items put out for bid to be viewed today: Micro-Surfacing, Cape-Sealing, Fuel Supply, Hot In Place Asphalt Recycling, Lane Striping, and Asphalt Overlays. There were three total bids received as follows:

1. Bid #240128-F- Diesel Fuel and Gasoline
 - a. Frisco Fuel, LLC out of Stoutland, MO was the only bidder. Commissioner Williams made a motion to accept the bid from Frisco Fuel. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).
2. Bid #240128-Z- Lane Striping
 - a. K.W. Luetkemeyer Painting & Wallcovering, Co. Inc was the only bidder. Commissioner Williams made a motion to accept the bid from K.W. Luetkemeyer. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).
3. Bid #240128-HR- Hot In Place Recycling
 - a. Gallagher Asphalt Corporation out of Thornton, IL was the only bidder. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to accept the bid from Gallagher Asphalt. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Williams (aye).

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote:
