

COUNTY COMMISSION RECORD, CAMDEN COUNTY, MISSOURI

Thursday 04/25/2024

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, First District Commissioner James Gohagan, and Second District Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve today's agenda. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve April 23, 2024 meeting minutes. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

New Business

Planning and Zoning Board Reappointments- Two board members' terms are due to expire at the end of April 2024. Both board members expressed desire to remain serving on the board. Commissioner Williams made a motion to reappoint Ray Waltman to the Planning and Zoning board for a four-year term.

Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). Commissioner Williams made a motion to reappoint Jordan Webb to the Planning and Zoning board for a four-year term. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Sewer Board Appointment- Camden County Planning and Permitting Administrator alerted the commission via email that a Camden County Sewer

Board member for Normac Estates District has resigned per the last meeting they had, but the replacement accompanied them to the meeting and expressed his desire to fill in on the board for the remainder of the active term. Commissioner Williams made a motion to appoint Don Murphy to the Camden County Sewer Board. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

County Agreement for Fuel Tank Installation and Use with Northwest Fire Protection District- Camden County Road and Bridge Administrator, County Counselor, and a representative of the Northwest Fire Protection District were able to reach an agreement in regard to a fueling station for the county being on the Northwest Fire Protection District's property. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve this agreement. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Assessor- Contract with SAM (Surveying and Mapping, LLC)- Professional GIS Services- This new contract will provide upgrades to GIS services and will be paid for out of the County Assessor's budget as a one time payment of \$18,250.00. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve this contract with SAM LLC. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Skelton (aye).

Discuss Juvenile Justice Center repairs needed- There is a known issue with water pooling up, getting underneath the building, and causing issues with the foundation of the Mary Dickerson Juvenile Justice Center. Many entities have taken a look at the issue and it has now been discussed that repair quotes should be put out for bid. Commissioner Williams made a motion to put this work needed for drain installation and repairs out for bid. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Other Business

At this time, Commissioner Skelton opened the floor to the public. A Mr. Charles Hartley stepped forward, stated his name for the record and directed his attention to the commission in regard to an issue he has had with the Sheriff's Department. He requested the commission draft a formal letter stating what their duties and powers are over the Sheriff's Department. Commissioner Gohagan directed Mr. Hartley to review Missouri Statute 49 to find the information he was looking for. The conversation and explanation of issue continued on for a short while until Mr. Hartley dismissed himself. There were no motions or actions taken on this matter.

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Williams (aye). Session closed at 10:27 A.M.
