The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Greg Hasty, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve today's agenda. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Hasty (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

New Business

Collector – 2021 Tax Sale Publication Bid – Two bids were received for the 2021 Tax Sale Publication. The bids were from Reporter Publishing and Lake Media. Commissioner Williams made a motion to table the bids pending further review from the Collector's Office. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Building Appraisal Bid – No bids were received for the building appraisal. After discussion Commissioner Williams made a motion to table the bid request and reach out to Connie Mudge and other building appraisers. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Sheriff – Bail Bonds Agreement – The Sheriff’s Office presented an agreement with the bail bonds company to continue advertising their business on the CCTV at the jail. Certified Copy of Order – The Commission was presented with a Court Order supporting the budget amendment of April 13, 2021 for the purpose of funding an addition Court Security Officer for two years. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the court order. . Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Gohagan (Yes). Roll call vote; Commissioner Gohagan (Aye), Commissioner Williams (Aye) and Commissioner Hasty (Aye). Commissioner Williams made a motion at 11:29 A.M. to go out of closed session. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Hasty (Yes). Roll call vote; Commissioner Williams (Aye), Commissioner Gohagan (Absent), and Commissioner Hasty (Aye).

1:00 PM Macks Creek Water District – Commissioner Hasty and Commissioner Gohagan met with County Auditor Jimmy Laughlin, County Treasurer Kendra Hicks, County Attorney Charles McElyea, and Kathy Fewell to discuss a block grant for the Macks Creek Water District. No votes were taken.
