

COUNTY COMMISSION RECORD, CAMDEN COUNTY, MISSOURI

Thursday 05/18/2023

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to amend today's agenda to switch the order of the items on the agenda and discuss Bollinger Creek under old business. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to accept the May 18, 2023 minutes. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes).

New Business

County Purple Heart Designation- The Commission heard from Carl with American Legion Post 624 regarding Camden County becoming a Purple Heart county. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the Camden County Missouri Proclamation. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

Capital Academy-The Commission heard from employees of Capital Academy, an umbrella company under Capital Paving and Construction, which provides training for students just out of school that may want to learn a trade. Some examples of the training they offer would teach students how to build roads, install culverts, and build bridges. Capital Academy wishes to enter into a partnership with the

county in the future that would provide labor and some machinery for work that needs completed within the county. There were no actions made on this item.

Other Business

Bollinger Creek- Under previous administration, \$80,000 in ARPA funds were allocated to fixing the issues with this creek that have caused a cemetery to start washing out. The creek is shifting and projected to soon take out the cemetery completely and possibly the road. The Commission agreed that they need to work quickly and efficiently to find a solution. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to table this item on the agenda until next Thursday, May 25, 2023.

Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (yes) and Commissioner Williams (yes).

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes). Session closed at 10:46 A.M.
