The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

### **Meeting Agenda**

#### **New Business**

**Road and Bridge Updates-** The Commission gave a brief update on some road projects the R&B Dept. have been working on. There were no motions made.

**Spyglass- Phone System Evaluation-** Commissioner Skelton explained that he was contacted by an employee of Spyglass about their technological services they offer. There were county employees in attendance that discussed their thoughts on a new phone system. There were no motions made.

**Other Communications/Issues brought to the Commission**- The Commission discussed the Camden County Library Board, abatements in the Assessor's Office, sales tax income for the county, property assessments, the CCAYEC feasability study, a discrepency in the 2023 County Revenue portion of the final budget, and

the newly presented SB190 bill and the effects for departments in the county if passed. There were no motions made on any of these topics.

**Elected Officials-** Camden County Assessor, Marty McGuire, explained to the Commission that there is a shortage of affordable child care in the county and daycares are closing all around, and it could cause the county to lose employees. There were no motions made.
