The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve today's agenda. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to accept the June 14, 2023 minutes. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes).

New Business

Auctioneer Service Bid Acceptance- The Camden County Clerk's Office received zero bids for this service. The Commission will decide how to proceed with the sale of some county owned surplus land at next Tuesday's meeting. There were no motions made.

Auditing Service Bid Acceptance- The Camden County Clerk's Office received zero bids for this service. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to table this item on the agenda. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Horseshoe Bend Special Road District- ARPA Request- The Horseshoe Bend Special Road district has paid for improvements to some shoulders on their roads and request to partner in paying for the work being completed in the area. The total amount paid was just shy of \$10,000.00. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to reimburse the Horseshoe Bend Special Road District \$5,000.00 out of ARPA funds. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Robert Harris- Airbnb Discussion- There were no actions taken on this matter.

MU Extension Presentation- Dr. Ashley Allen-Brown- The Commission heard from Dr. Ashley Allen-Brown regarding a proposal for a mentoring program called REACH: Building Resilient Economics and Community Health. She submitted a draft along with the economic overview of 2023 from the MU Extension thus far into the year. She only requested the Commission's blessing for this program. Commissioner Skelton asked that Dr. Brown give the Commission some time to read over the draft and look through the economic overview before giving their blessing. There were no motions made.
