The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Greg Hasty, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve today's agenda. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to table the minutes for June 17 and 23, 2021. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

New Business

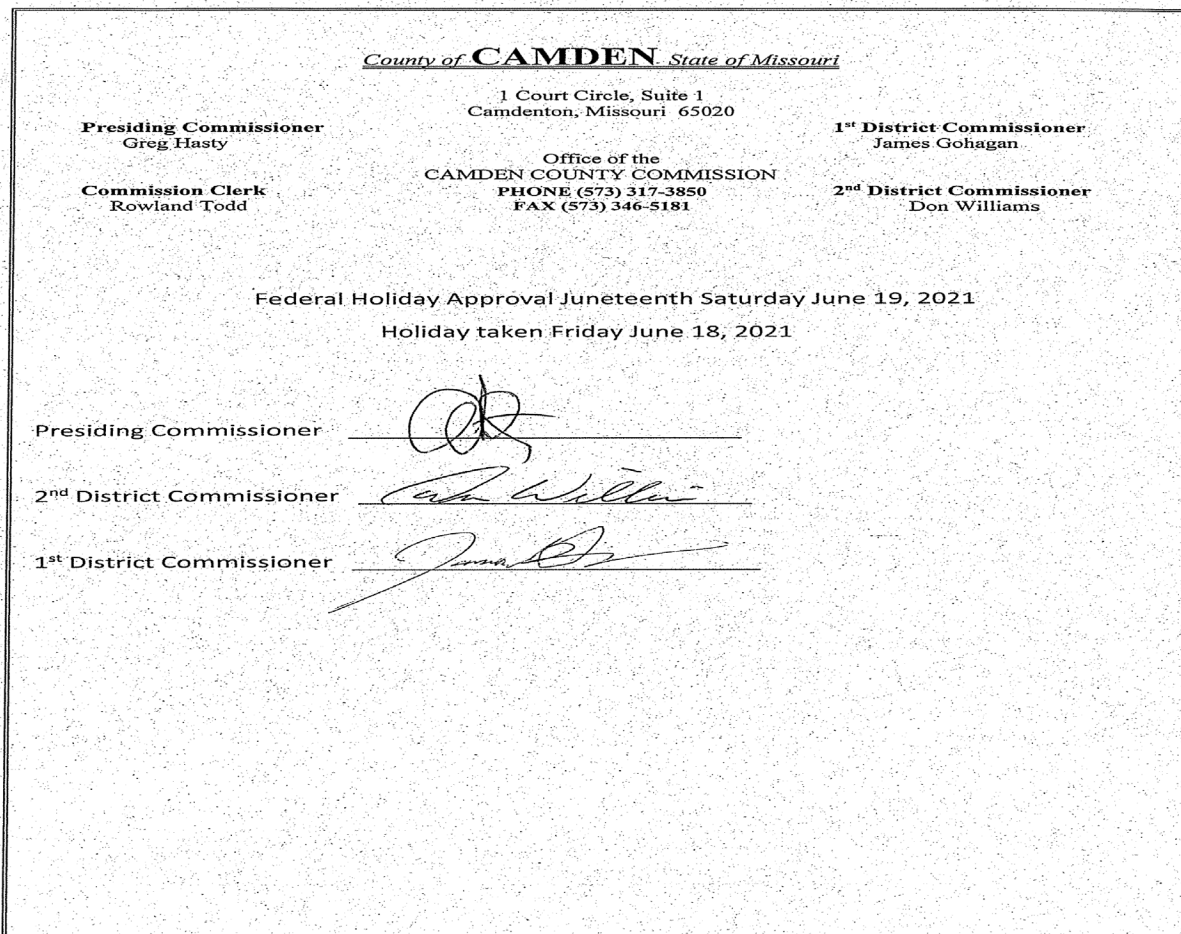
Treasurer – Banking Request for Proposal – The Treasurer received only 1 proposal for banking. Commissioner Gohagan then made a motion to table the proposal at the request of the Treasurer to give her time to review. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

Health Official Appointment – Commissioner Williams made a motion to authorize Stephanie Dake, the Health Department Administrator, to engage in agreements and contracts concerning the Health Department. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

Request for Surplus Money – There were 2 requests for surplus money by property owners from the tax sale. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the requests. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Southwest Mo. Forensics – There were no bids received for the medical examiner services for the County. Southwest Mo Forensics presented an agreement for the services. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the agreement. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

Holiday Approval – A new federal holiday was created for Juneteenth. The Commission agreed to recognize the holiday and the county observed the holiday on June 18, 2021. Commissioner Williams made a motion to ratify the decision to observe the holiday. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).



Sheriff – Bondsman Agreements – The Sheriff’s Office presented agreements with 2 companies wishing to purchase advertising space on the closed circuit television for information benefitting jail inmates. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the agreements. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).
