

COUNTY COMMISSION RECORD, CAMDEN COUNTY, MISSOURI

Thursday 07/25/2024

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, First District Commissioner James Gohagan and Second District Commissioner Don Williams.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to approve today's agenda. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Williams (aye). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve July 18, 2024 meeting minutes. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

New Business

Agreement between Climax Springs School & Camden County to allow parking of road graders on school property- This agreement will allow the road and bridge crew with road graders in the Climax Springs area to park their graders on school property so they're not being kept at employees' homes. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to accept and approve this agreement between Climax Springs School and Camden County. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (aye) and Commissioner Williams (aye).

Contract with Forvis Mazars, LLP for grant management services for the Human Trafficking grant- An extension for spending of the Human Trafficking grant funds was approved, so Forvis' services are needed for the extension period of the grant

for reporting requirements. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve this extension of services provided by Forvis Mazars, LLP. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Senior Services Fund Board reappointment- Jim Powell- Commissioner Williams made a motion to reappoint Jim Powell to the Camden County Senior Services Fund Board for a four-year term. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Budget amendment for new printer- Commission Office- Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the budget amendment for \$6,620.00 from General Revenue to the Commission Equipment General Ledger Line for the purchase of a new printer. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye).

Discuss budget cycle management software- Commissioner Skelton discussed the need to have an easier-to-read/understand budget accessible to our citizens and provided some insight to a software program he'd learned about while at the Tampa, FL NACO conference. Jimmy Laughlin (Auditor) stated that he had previously looked into that software and that it was expensive compared to other softwares. Jimmy also stated that there were parts of the current accounting software BS&A that were not being used, yet; such as a "transparency side". His office is working to implement that and hopes to have it ready to launch this fall. There were no motions made on this agenda item.

Old Business

Tranquil Woods Road- The issue regarding pavement of Tranquil Woods Road was brought up during this commission meeting. Commissioner Gohagan stated that he did not promise to pave this road. There were several citizens in attendance to speak on their already paved road that's deteriorating and basically gravel in several parts of the road. Their pleas to the commission were to take care of the roads that are already paved in the county instead of spending more

money to take gravel roads to paved roads. There were no motions made on this issue.

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda, Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (aye) and Commissioner Gohagan (aye). Session closed at 11:30 A.M.
