Meeting Agenda

2022 CART Funds- Horseshoe Bend- Camden County receives CART Funds from the state every year to be dispersed. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to sign the certified copy of order to disperse \$367,975.74 from Camden County Road and Bridge to Horseshoe Bend Special Road District. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes).




July TERM 2023



In God We Trust- While attending the NACO annual conference in Austin, TX, Commissioner Skelton met a group of individuals with In God We Trust USA and learned that their goal is to get every municipality and county to display “In God We Trust”. The Commission encourages everyone within the county to get involved in this project and to submit ideas for a design to be painted on the wall in the meeting room behind them. Commissioner Skelton opened the floor to anyone who wished to speak on the matter. There were many parties present who expressed support for the cause. There were no parties in attendance who did not show support. Commissioner Williams made a motion to request proposals for artistic designs and concepts for the county that include the phrase “In God We Trust”. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (Yes).

SB190- State Representative Lisa Thomas, Presiding Commissioner of Miller County, and First District Commissioner of Miller County were all present for this item on the agenda. There are still many questions with the language of this law and how implementation of the law will work for citizens in Camden County. Camden County Attorney, Jeff Green, will be working closely with Camden County Assessor, Marty McGuire, and Collector, Teresa Murray, to try to work out the best way to draft an efficient ordinance that will hopefully eliminate and/or address questions that were asked today. Commissioner Gohagan made a motion to direct the county attorney to draft language for an ordinance for review on September 7, 2023. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Gohagan (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes).
