The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Ike Skelton, District #1 Commissioner James Gohagan, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams was absent until 10:05 A.M.

Meeting Agenda

Central Turf & Irrigation Supply Quote- Irrigation for Administration Building-
The Maintenance Manager presented a quote from Central Turf & Irrigation

Supply. This is the company that provided supplies when the maintenance team installed the current irrigation in portions of the courthouse lawn. Maintenance is requesting that this quote be considered in the budget for 2024. Commissioner Gohagan stated that he was in favor of adding this project to the next year's budget. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve maintenance's request for the quote from Central Turf & Irrigation Supply. Commissioner Gohagan seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (yes) and Commissioner Gohagan (yes).
