911 Tax Levy – Commissioner Thomas made a motion to reaffirm the E911 Tax Levy for 2021. Commissioner Thomas stated this is the same tax rate of fifteen percent that was established in November of 1997. This is the tariffed tax used for the landline phones and is a revenue that is steady decreasing. This tax cannot be changed without a vote of the people. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

Charter Contract – A new contract with Charter for telephone and internet services was presented to the commission. The new agreement reflects a rate savings average of 20%. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the new contract. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Williams (Yes).
