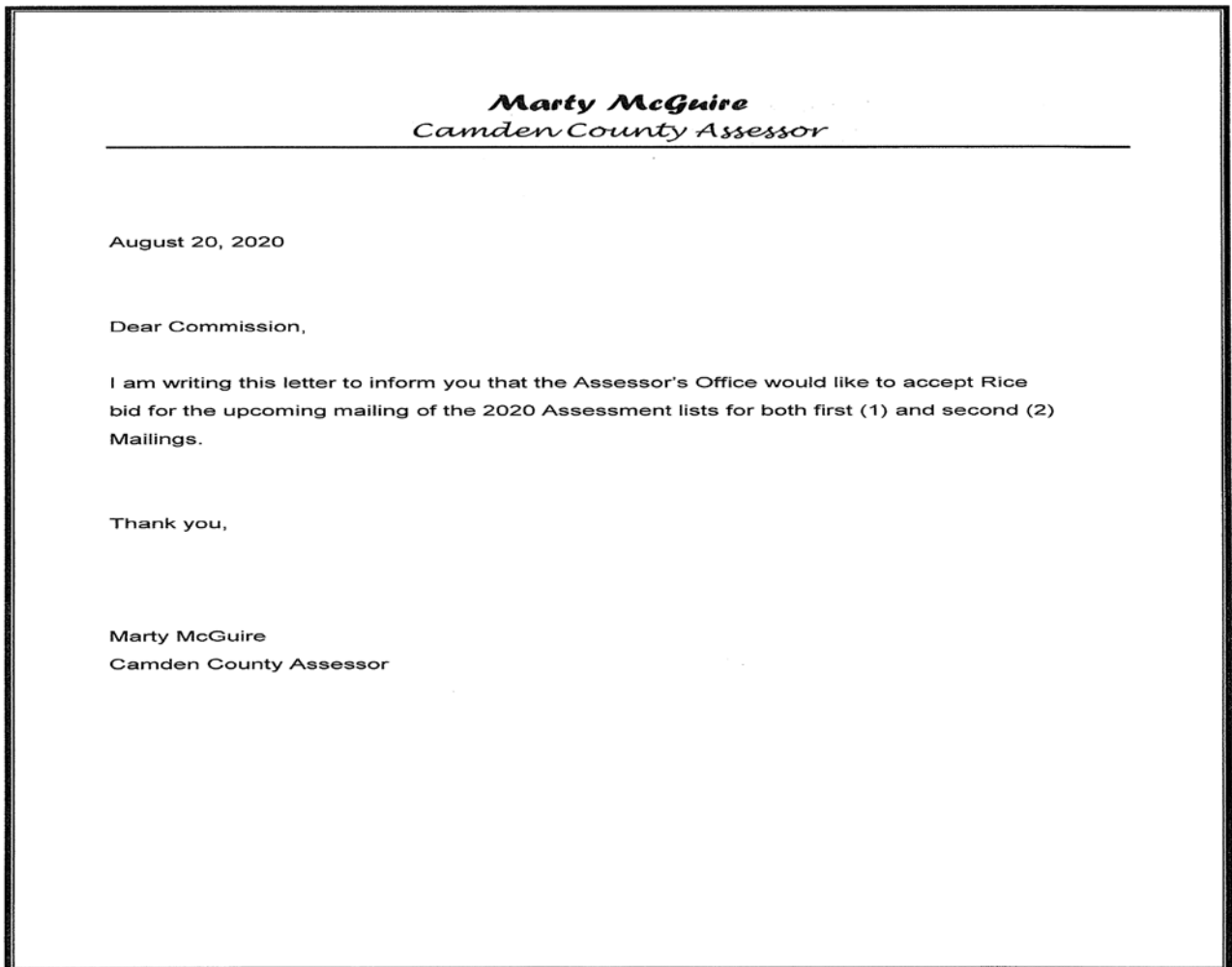
## Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to table the August 18 & 19, 2020 minutes. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

## New Business

**P&Z 20-101 Farrell-2 Parcels Rezone P-1 to A-R** – Planning and Zoning  
Administrator Tanna Wirtz states the rules and procedures for today's preceding. Commissioner Williams then made a motion to approve the planning and zoning minutes. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes). Commissioner Hasty then asked if the applicant is present. Applicant is present and is Justin Farrell. The parcels are approximately 18.5 acres to be rezoned from P-1 to A-R. Commissioner Williams recused himself because he owns property that adjoins this and would be personally impacted by it. Commissioner Hasty then asked if anyone in opposition is present. One person in opposition was present. The P&Z Board had voted 5/6 yes for rezoning with 1 abstaining. Commissioner Thomas then made a motion to deny the rezone. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Hasty (Yes).

**Assessor- Bid Acceptance** – The County Assessor presented an acceptance letter for the bid 200811 Assessment List Printing and Mailing to Rice. Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve the award. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), and Commissioner Thomas (Yes).



**Meeting with Chambers** – COVID-19 Business Assistance Grants. Camden County along with the Lake Area, Lake West, and Camdenton Chambers are working together to provide grants to small businesses impacted by COVID-19. Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve the Chamber's request under strict guidelines to authorize a formation of citizens to review applications for the CARES funds. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

**Adjourn:** With no further official business on the agenda: Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session closed at 10:38 A.M.
