TUESDAY 5/21/2019

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Greg Hasty, District #1 Commissioner Bev Thomas, and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams.

## Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve today's agenda as posted. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

## Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve May 2<sup>nd</sup>, May 7<sup>th</sup>, and May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019 minutes. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

## New Business

**Road & Bridge Bid Opening-** We have received four bids today. First Bid is from Bax Excavating LLC.; the second bid is from R& K Trucking, the third bid is from Ethan Myers, the fourth bid is from D & R Materials. Commissioner Thomas made a motion to table the bids for review by the road and bridge administrator. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion tabled by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes).

**Camden County Museum-** Commissioner Thomas stated that the County Museum is in need of repairs to the roof as it is leaking. The museum has started a fundraiser to try to raise the \$5,000.00 they need for roof repairs, but as of today they have only raised two hundred and forty dollars. Commissioner Thomas

made a suggestion to donate \$1,000.00 out of passport funds to the museum. After a brief discussion with all three commissioners, they have decided to donate \$2,500.00 and help them get in contact with the right people to sign up to receive some other historic grants to help with future cost that may occur. Commissioner Thomas then made a motion to donate \$2,500.00 to the County Museum for roof repairs. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes).
