Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve today's agenda as posted. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve July 16, 2019 minutes. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), Commissioner Williams (Yes).

New Business

P & Z 19-127 Rezone DDK (R-1 to B-2)- Planning and Zoning Administrator Tanna Wirtz states with the rules and procedures for today's preceding. Commissioner Thomas then made a motion to approve the planning and zoning minutes. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes). Commissioner Hasty then asked if the applicant is present. Applicant is present and is David Dailing. The parcel is 10.6 acre and has two parcels with two zones on record. Commissioner Hasty then asked if anyone in opposition is present. No one in opposition is present. Commissioner Williams then made a motion to approve the rezone as the planning and zoning board has elected to do. Commissioner Thomas

seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes).

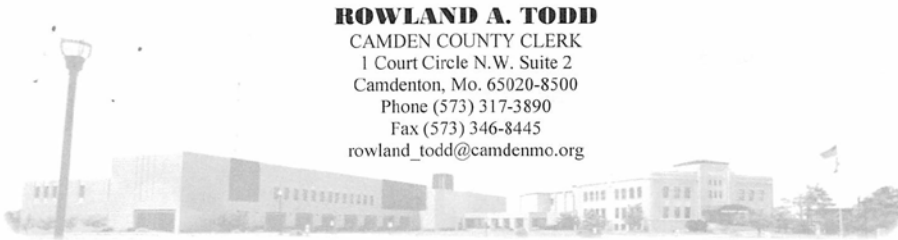
P & Z 19-259 Stadter Rezone (R-2 to I-1)- Planning and Zoning Administrator

Tanna Wirtz states the rules to do rezone. Commissioner Hasty then asked if the applicant is present. Applicant is present and is Richard Stadter Jr. Commissioner Hasty asked Mr. Stadter to explain what the rezone is going to be for?

Commissioner Hasty asked what the vote for this property was. Planning and Zoning Administrator stated the board voted four of four with anonymous approval. Commissioner Hasty then asked if anyone in opposition is present. A total of four people spoke in opposition with the primary concerns being; traffic, smell, safety and property value. Commissioner Williams then made a motion to approve the rezone with setting aside his personal reservations. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion with stating that she knows many things would be considerably worse than this option. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes).

R&B Contracts – County Engineer Lee Schuman stated this is just to sign the contracts for the bids already accepted. No motion taken just two contracts signed. One contract is for Ethan Myers and the other is for R& K Trucking. Signed copy forwarded to county clerk and county auditor.

County Clerk Bid Acceptance – Commissioner Thomas made a motion to accept the recommendation of the County Clerk for the printing bid for the voter ID. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes).
