Regarding the bids submitted for the printing, stuffing and mailing of the 2019 Current Tax Statements in October 2019 and Delinquent Tax Statements in April 2020.

The only bids received were from Edward J Rice in Springfield, MO and MastersTouch which is a company based out of the states of Washington and Iowa.

There are lots of changes to this years process, mainly the printing companies involvement is not as detailed as in years past, the IT will be submitting the tax statements to the company in PDF form, whereas prior they have received the tax records and inserted info into form.

Although Edward J Rice's bid was \$1,846.95 more, they are a Missouri based company and we have dealt with them for many years, we have opted to accept their bid.


