First bid received is from Knapheide and is for \$7,980.00. The second bid received is from Valk Manufacturing Company and is for \$7,216.00. The third bid received is from Henderson Products Inc. and is for \$6,921.00. The second bid opening for today is for a stainless steel spreader. Two bids are received for the spreader. The first bid is from Knapheide. The chain bid is for \$16,500.00. The single auger is for \$21,350 and the dual auger is for \$25,250.00. The second bid received is from Henderson Products Inc. The chain bid is for \$14,869.00. The single auger is for \$ 17,533.00 No bid received for the

dual auger. The third and final bid opening for today is for Tandem Axle Dump Truck. We received three bids for the tandem axle dump truck bid. First bid is from Columbia Freightliner, Henderson Products and Knapheide Equipment with three separate options listed. The second bid is from Scheppers International Truck Center with two separate options listed. Third bid is from Summit Truck Group with two separate options listed. Commissioner Williams made a motion to table all the bids received today to allow time for review. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes).
