Road & Bridge Speed Limit Old S. 5 – County Engineer Lee Schuman stated that a resident in Decaturville has recently requested that the speed limit be reduced near the Mount Horeb Rd intersection with Old South Five. Lee stated that horizontal alignment is adequate for fifty-five miles per hour, but the vertical alignment severely limits the sight distance at the Mount Horeb Road intersection. This intersection is the primary intersection for traffic leaving the new highway five alignment. From a vehicle stopped on Mount Horeb road ten feet from the edge of Old South Five a driver can see over twenty-five hundred feet to the south but only three hundred fifty-five feet to the north. Lee recommends that the speed limit on Old South Five be reduced to forty miles per

hour from seven hundred fifty feet north of the County Route P intersection to two hundred fifty feet south of Mount Horeb Road intersection. Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve the sign changes. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes).

Description of Item:

Reduced Speed Limit – Old South 5

A Camden County resident in Decaturville recently requested that the speed limit be reduced near the Mount Horeb Rd intersection with Old South 5. The current speed limit is posted at 55 miles per hour (mph) for the entire length of the roadway.

Why is Commission Action Required?

To establish a speed limit other than 35 mph

Are there any deadlines associated with this action?

Road & Bridge Department staff should be available in the next 4-6 weeks to install new speed limit and reduced speed zone ahead signs. The signs will have to be ordered, because they are currently not in our inventory.

Comments and Recommendation of Department:

While the horizontal alignment is adequate for 55 mph, the vertical alignment severely limits sight distance at the Mount Horeb Rd intersection. This intersection is the primary intersection for traffic leaving the new Highway 5 alignment. From a vehicle stopped on Mount Horeb ten feet from the edge of Old South 5, a driver can see over 2500 feet to the south, but only 355 feet to the north.

The County Engineer recommends that the speed limit on Old South 5 be reduced to 40 miles per hour (mph) from 750 feet north of the County Route P intersection to 250 feet south of the Mount Horeb Road intersection.

LO Sign – Commissioner Thomas stated she was approached to donate to the repairs of the Lake Ozark lighted sign since the county had provided a donation last time. Commissioner Thomas discussed with the other commissioners to donate \$1,000.00 out of passport funds. Commission agrees to donation. Commissioner Thomas made a motion to donate \$1,000.00 to the chamber for the Lake Ozark sign. Commissioner Williams seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes).

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda: Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Thomas seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session closed at 10:22 A.M.
