TUESDAY, DECEMBER 12th, 2017

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Greg Hasty, District #2 Commissioner Don Williams and District #1 Commissioner Bev Thomas out of office.

Meeting Agenda

Commissioner Williams made a motion to approve today's agenda as posted Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes), Commissioner Hasty (Yes). Session opened at 10:00 A.M.

Prior Minutes

Commissioner Williams made a table to accept the Commissioner minutes dated November 28th, 30th and December 5th, 7th, 8th 2017. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Williams (Yes) and Commissioner Hasty (Yes).

New Business

STATE AUDTIOR BRIEFING: Commissioner Hasty introduced Deborah Whitis from the State Auditor's office. Deborah started off with an introduction, general rules and procedures. She stated that they also noticed that in May the previous Collector had retired so they are required to do a close out audit for her. Deborah then stated that the bill for the close out audit and the regular audit will be between \$100,000 and \$150,000. In this bill it will only be for the actual hours worked by the staff and can take up to four to five months. Once they are done with the field work they will go back to the office and create a draft. Then a exit meeting will happen and this meeting will be a closed session. After this is completed another series happens and Nicole Galloway receives the draft and reviews. Once reviewed and approved a report will be released. They will also

have a press release that will be open to the public. Deborah stated as she was closing the meeting that if anyone has any concerns please submit them while they are here working not as they are leaving. She also stated that any concerns on the petition are private and will not be discussed while anyone.

Adjourn: With no further official business on the agenda: Commissioner Williams made a motion to adjourn to any unofficial business that may develop during the day. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Hasty (Yes) and Commissioner Williams (Yes). Session closed at 10:20 A.M.
