**WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 31<sup>ST</sup>, 2018**

The Camden County Commission met with Presiding Commissioner Greg Hasty, District #1 Commissioner Beverly Thomas and District #2 Commissioner Don Williams is out of office.

**Meeting Agenda**

Commissioner Thomas made a motion to amend today's agenda as posted and move the bids acceptance to the last item on agenda. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Commissioner Hasty (Yes), Commissioner Thomas (Yes). Session opened at 11:40 A.M.

**HRSBD:** Commissioner Thomas stated that this is a TDD that the county accepted roads on and now we are relinquishing those roads back to HSBRD for CART funds. Commissioner Thomas made a motion to relinquish ownership back to the

Lodge of Four Seasons and that HSBRD has already signed off on this form. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. The motion is passed by vote: Commissioner Hasty (Yes) and Commissioner Thomas (Yes). Copy of agreement is attached.

**CADV:** Commissioner Thomas stated this is for the CADV fund that the County Treasurer Holds these funds until commission votes to release fund to CADV. Commissioner Thomas made a motion to disburse the funds to CADV. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. Motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Hasty (Yes).

**POSTAGE MACHINE CONTRACT:** Commissioner Thomas made a motion to accept the contract from MailFinance for a new, larger postage machine in the amount of 808.86 per month, to be paid quarterly based on the recommendation of the Purchasing Department Administrator. This machine was obtained on State Bid. Commissioner Hasty seconded the motion. Motion passed by vote: Commissioner Thomas (Yes), and Commissioner Hasty (Yes).
