

JOB TITLE: Detention Officer

DEPARTMENT: Camden County Sheriff's Office

JOB SUMMARY: This position is responsible for working with the jail inmates in the Sheriff's Department

MAJOR DUTIES:

Work in a team environment to deal with those who are incarcerated in the Camden County jail. Will deliver and remove food trays, assist with transportation to and from the Courthouse. All other duties as assigned.

PERSONAL CONTACTS: Contacts are typically with co-workers, inmates, and representatives of other law enforcement agencies.

PURPOSE OF CONTACTS: Contacts are typically to give or exchange information, to resolve problems, to provide services.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: The work is very physical in nature, standing, bending, crouching, or stooping, occasional sitting. The employee frequently lifts light and heavy objects, uses tools or equipment requiring a high degree of dexterity, and must be able to distinguish between shades of color.

WORK ENVIRONMENT: The work is typically performed in the Detention Center.

SUPERVISORY AND MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITY: None.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- * 18 years or older
- * Possess a valid Driver's License
- * High School diploma or GED
- * No felony convictions, must pass a background screening
- * Must pass a Drug screen.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- * Prior experience as a Corrections Officer desirable.
